<p>Site Protocols / Emergency Procedures FH explained the site protocols/emergency procedures with the group attending the meeting at Fulton Hogan's Miners Road Laboratory Training Room</p>
<p>Purpose reiterated The purpose of the CLG must include, but not be limited to, the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) Engagement on an on-going and regular basis on matters associated with the quarrying operations including compliance with CRC resource consents; ii) Promotion of the flow of information relating to all District and Regional consents relating to the quarry including dust monitoring data (including location), metrological data, water abstraction data and groundwater quality data via a publicly available electronic sharing platform, established, operated and maintained by the consent holder to be utilised by the local community and the consent holder so as to, wherever possible, address any issues that may arise; and iii) To discuss the results of monitoring and any matters that may arise as a result of the monitoring
<p>Previous Minutes</p> <p>To add to the minutes There was discussion about the promises made by Fulton Hogan during the hearing to provide data – dust, water usage, wind etc. There is community concern that this is not yet available electronically, and it is undermining confidence in the process that was set up, and confidence that the quarry will perform to the high standards set through the hearing. With that change the minutes were approved.</p>

Update from Fulton Hogan

- Roydon Quarry Community Update was distributed to TRA in June 2023. The article was shared to the TRA Facebook page.
- Another update has been shared for inclusion for Templeton Tales provided to TRA for inclusion on Facebook and article.
- Feedback on the updates will likely to come in after the distribution of the newsletter at the AGM which is booked to be held next month.
- Photo updates of the Roydon site was shared with the group on screen.
- First response received from SDC around the perimeter walking track, currently working through the technical detail.
- Processing plant equipment will start arriving on site pre-Christmas, most will be in 2024
- Drone photos were taken onsite 14/08 – these will be distributed once we receive them.
- Naming of the quarry access road as McDowell Drive, an unveiling was held on Friday 11/08.
- Famer contractor has been engaged to monitor and maintain grass on the remainder of the site.
- Update on the Fulton Hogan website shared with group.
- Website is live – but not publicly accessible.
- Website will provide last 7 days worth of data for wind direction, wind speed, air quality, ground water conductivity and water use (m3 per day).
- Conductivity sensors are not connected as yet as the quarry is not operational as yet.
- Feedback from the group was access to historical data on the website would be beneficial.
- There are five dust monitors and a reference monitor. Every year there is an annual calibration of the reference monitor. Data from output of monitors are regularly reviewed to ensure the data is accurate.
- Suggestion to have calibration records publicly available.
- Suggestion to provide Council boundaries (SDC/CCC) on website for community to understand where the consents sit etc.
- Currently progressing updates of the website, will have the one on one with CLG group members gain feedback and then website will go live.

Incidents and Complaints

- CAMs register was distributed to the group prior to the meeting.
- CAMs register was read through.
- SDC/ECAN have received multiple statements/complaints from one entity which SDC has addressed directly with this entity and they do not have any reason to take any action as they are comfortable with the operations onsite.
- Fulton Hogan extended an invitation to a complainant to visit the quarry site to address their concerns, the invitation was declined.
