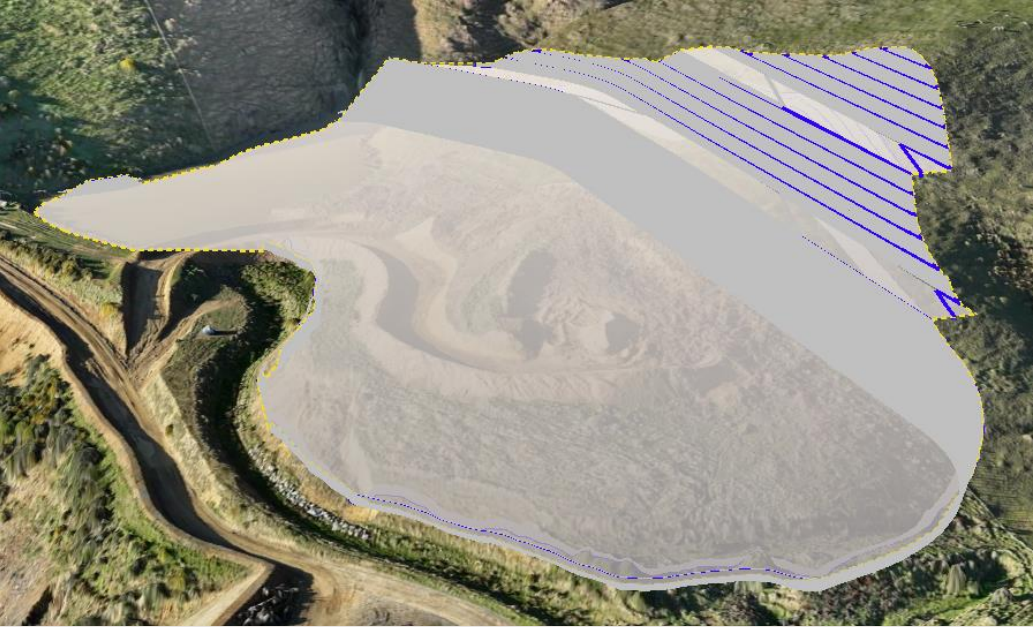

- ❖ Open quarry to Account holders

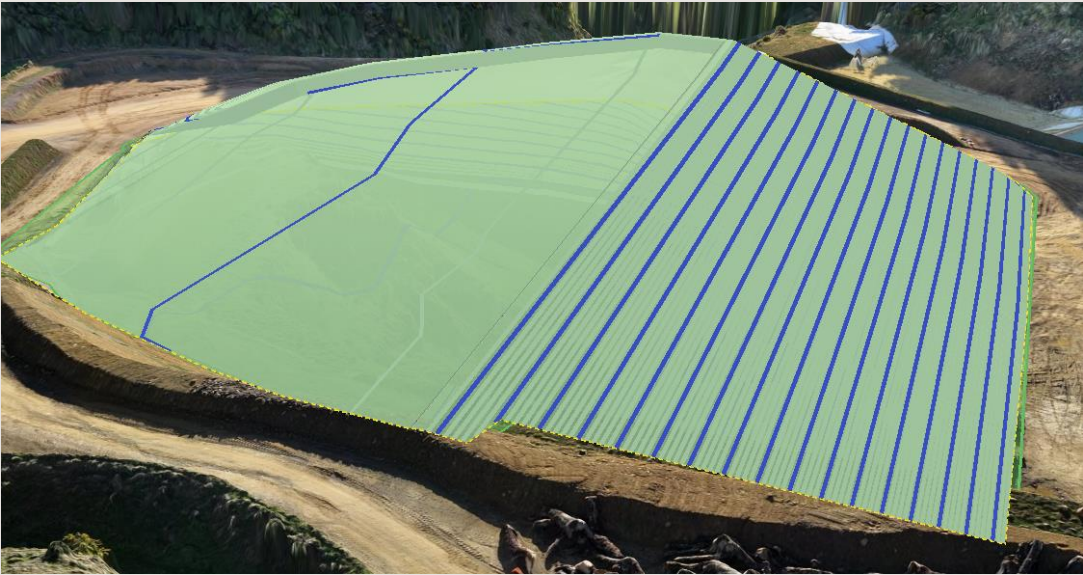
Stage 1 Overburden Removal

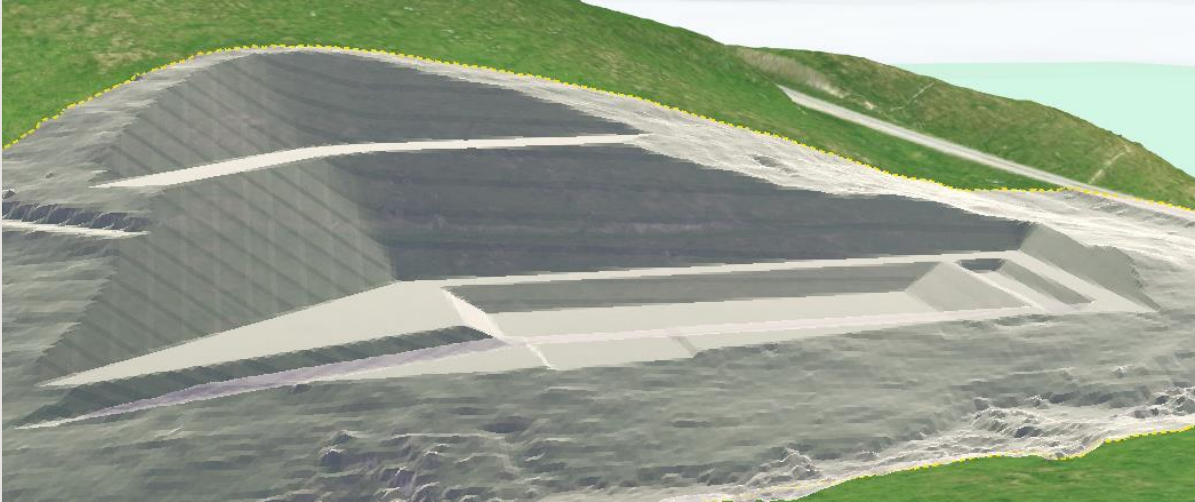

- ✓ Stripping and rock extraction on stage 2

- ✓ Set up fixed blasting monitor for trials
